WHAT IS THE COWBOY LEGACY REUNION & RODEO?

In 1959, William H. (Bill) Hogg, a lifetime resident of Mansfield, opened the world's first indoor rodeo properly named The Kowbell Indoor Rodeo. Every Saturday night throughout the year, cowboy's and cowgirls from all over the great state of Texas came to participate in the Rodeo as well as practices during the week. When Bill Hogg passed away in 1961, The Ratjen family carried on The Kowbell Rodeo Legacy for 45 more years. MISD purchased the property from the Ratjen's in 2004 where they built Legacy High School in it's place. In honor of the arena they proudly deemed the mascot The Broncos.



For many, Kowbell was like their second home! The family worked very hard to make sure that regardless of your age you had a place in rodeo. It is that love of the rodeo that we keep alive!

In 2009, a group of individuals that called Kowbell home, created a committee with the desire to host a yearly rodeo in memory of the Kowbell. The plan was to host the rodeo and give back to the community. But over the years The Cowboy Legacy Reunion Rodeo has become much more!

Every year the committee recognizes past contestants of Kowbell. By honoring these individuals it has created "The Reunion" during the rodeo. A scholarship program was created as well. Mr. Hogg was a firm believer in rodeo and advanced education. He himself was a graduate of Texas A&M. In his honor each year one or more high school seniors are selected for a \$1000 scholarship. Our desire to give back to the community has benefitted several charities, from the Special Olympics, Leukemia Texas, The Wounded Warrior Program and now Texas Cowboys Against Cancer.



It is with smiles on our faces and love in our hearts that we get to celebrate The Legacy of The Kowbell Rodeo every year. And with every year it grows bigger and better!

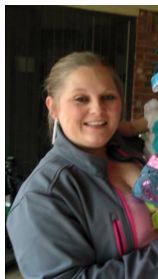

Texas Cowboys Against Cancer



Every year The Cowboy Legacy Reunion Rodeo gives back to a chosen charity. We have partnered up with Cowboys Against Cancer for a 3rd year. In 2018 we were able to donate \$2,500 to TCAC. Texas Cowboys Against Cancer is a non-profit organization that provides financial support to recipient (s) each year with cancer in the western heritage community who is uninsured or under-insured.

Even in the best of situations, cancer can be devastating. The physical and mental effects are often exacerbated by the financial strain placed on the patient and their family.

Texas Cowboys Against Cancer (TCAC) is the direct outgrowth of the successful benefits held for Johnnie Neely in 2009 and Jim Saunders in 2010 to help defray the costs associated with their treatment for cancer. Our organization was formed to assist others who find themselves in similar circumstances.

TCAC strives to lessen the burden for cancer patient (s) each year by providing financial support so our recipient and their family can focus on winning the fight against cancer. Sadly, some of our awards have been given posthumously. In that case, the money is given directly to the family to help cover remaining medical bills and funeral expenses.

Scholarships

Every year The Cowboy Legacy Reunion Rodeo awards one or more local high school students a \$1000 scholarship. All applicants must fill out all necessary forms and have them submitted before the deadline. Most applicants are rodeo active competing at the high school level in local schools. Recipients must have proof of enrollment to receive scholarship. We have been very proud of all of our past recipients and look forward to many more!
